1. This is a team competition.
2. All 2008-09 Certified League champions will be invited, Adult and Youth.
 - a. Adult teams will be five bowlers. If league playing strength is less than 5, the champion team can pick up the needed bowlers from anyone in the league. Bowlers must have bowled 2/3 of the league schedule to be eligible.
 - b. Youth teams will be four bowlers. If the league playing strength is less than 4, the champion team can pick up the needed bowlers from 1) in the league; 2) in the center; 3) any Youth bowler. (minimum of 15 games)
3. Format will be six BAKER games. Total pins plus handicap will determine winners.
 - a. Handicap will be 90% of 200. Team average will be the overall average of the five bowlers. The entering average will be the final 2008-09 average from the league they advanced as champions.
 - b. Teams will move lanes after 2 games.
4. Entry fee: Adults, \$20.00 per bowler (\$100.00 per team).
 Breakdown: Lineage \$19.49, expense \$10.51, prize fund \$70.00
 Youth, \$15.00 per bowler (\$60.00 per team)
 Breakdown: lineage \$19.49, expense \$10.51, prize fund \$30.00
5. Suitable awards will be presented to the championship team. All prize money will be returned 100%. Excess expense fee may be used as prize money. Prize fund will be paid on a minimum of 1 for 6 ratio. Youth prizes will be awarded as scholarships deposited into SMART.
6. If a listed bowler does not show up, the tournament management may authorize a substitute bowler.
7. A bowler may compete on more than one team provided he/she was a member of that team in the league from which the team advanced.
8. All rules not listed above will be governed by the USBC Playing Rules Book.
