# 3rd ANNUAL METRO PHOENIX 2 X 2 MIXED DOUBLES TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES

*All Metro Phoenix tournaments are open to all currently USBC certified bowlers within the state of Arizona and Blythe, CA*

1. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST HAVE A CURRENT USBC MEMBERSHIP CARD IN ANY ASSOCIATION WITHIN ARIZONA OR BLYTHE, CALIFORNIA. Membership cards will be sold at the tournament site.
  - a. Doubles teams must be comprised of one male and one female bowler.
  - b. Members of any professional bowlers' organization shall be limited to one (1) member per doubles team.
2. A bowler may bowl multiple times but cash only once in each division, handicap or scratch, with the same partner.
3. Two games will be bowled on one pair of lanes. Lanes assigned by Tournament Director
4. Entries will be accepted on site. Bowlers may bowl anytime between 10:0am and 4:00pm. Last start time will be 4:00pm.
5. **Averages:** USBC Rule 319(a1) and 319(a3) are applicable for this tournament. Rule 319(a2) is not applicable.
  - a. Entrants shall use their highest 2009-10 book average.
  - b. If no 2009-10 book average is available, the bowler will use the highest average 2008-09 book average.
  - c. If no 2009-10 or 2008-09 book, the bowler will use the highest 2010 summer league average of 21 or more games as of 8/1/10.
  - d. If none of the above, the bowler will be assigned an average of 230.
  - e. Bowlers with a Sport/PBA Experience average or an average from a league using lane conditions other than the normal house pattern may rerated.
  - f. It shall be the responsibility of each bowler to verify their own average whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or other person. Failure to use the proper average will result in disqualification if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series.
6. USBC Rule 319(c) dealing with AVERAGE ADJUSTMENTS (RERATING) applies.
7. Handicap is based upon 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230.
8. Tournament participants are not allowed to practice within two hours of squad time on their scheduled lanes.
9. Trophies and Chevrons will be awarded to the Champions, handicap and scratch.
10. Prize fees will be returned 100% with a minimum ratio of 1 to 5 in each division. Excess expense fees will be added to the prize fund.
11. All prize fees for the Adult / Youth Division will be awarded as a scholarship for the youth. They will be deposited into SMART.
12. Late bowlers may bowl in accordance with USBC Rule 322.
13. Replacements made in any event must be in accordance with USBC Rule 324(b).
14. Substitutions made at the tournament site must complete the entire series in which they substituted.
15. No entry fees will be returned after practice has begun.
16. No unreasonable delay in the progress of any game will be permitted (USBC Rule 11).
17. All decisions of the tournament committee will be final unless an appeal is filed with tournament management (USBC Rule 329).
18. It is not necessary to report previous prize winnings.
19. In an effort to keep the squads on time, one-lane courtesy is requested.
20. The cleaning of the bowling ball surface, once certified competition has begun, is limited to a dry cloth towel, or dry cloth rag.
21. Tournament/Association management reserves the right to cancel any tournament due to lack of entries/participation by the closing date of the tournament, or as deemed necessary. All entries with fees would be returned to the team captains.

**The current USBC Book of Rules shall govern any rule not covered above.**
