Applicant shall be a junior or graduating high school senior planning to attend an accredited post-secondary learning institution, which includes any public or private university, junior or state college, technical institute or specialized trade school, or a continuing student attending any of the above listed schools. Applicants must fill out the attached applications. The request for scholarship funds shall be for attendance for any semester to any of the above listed schools as approved by the Scholarship Fund Board of Trustees.

The scholarship program has been established and funded by the Metro Phoenix USBC and will be an ongoing program for the youth bowlers of Phoenix. We encourage all youth bowlers graduating with the class of 2009 or 2010, and continuing students to apply.

YOUTH BOWLING SCHOLARSHIP FUND
CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I THE SCHOLARSHIP

- (a) Each scholarship shall be for one year. The sum shall be determined annually by the Metro Phoenix USBC (MPUSBC) Scholarship Committee, and is to be paid directly into the Smart Program. If the recipient does not claim the scholarship within four (4) years from graduation date from high school it shall revert back to the MPUSBC per Smart Program rules and regulations.
- (b) The request for the Scholarship Funds shall be for attendance to any recognized Junior or Senior College or University, trade school, teacher's college or other training school as approved by the MPUSBC Scholarship Committee.
- (c) Any student who has received a scholarship from the MPUSBC Scholarship Committee may make application for additional funds. The recipient may receive, with the approval of the Scholarship Committee, additional funds if such funds are available the following year.
- (d) No later than February 1st of each year, the Metro Phoenix USBC Scholarship Committee will make a financial statement available to the Metro Phoenix USBC Board of Directors.
- (e) Each scholarship awarded shall not exceed \$1,000.00.

ARTICLE II FUNDS

- (a) The scholarship funds shall come from:
 - 1. The Metro Phoenix USBC
 - 2. Contributions
 - 3. Fund raising projects established by the Metro Phoenix USBC
 - 4. Metro Phoenix USBC City Tournament Entry Forms.
- (b) Any and all legal contributions that might be presented to the Metro Phoenix USBC Scholarship Committee may be accepted and shall be deposited to the Metro Phoenix USBC Scholarship Fund. These funds shall be disbursed at the discretion of the Committee to the Smart Program. Upon receipt of any contribution, a receipt shall be mailed to the donor and the copy shall be retained for auditing purposes. A letter shall be sent by the Committee acknowledging the donation.
- (c) A petty cash fund will be set up for operating expenses for the use of Metro Phoenix USBC Scholarship Committee. Receipts for the operating expenses will be submitted to the Metro Phoenix USBC Treasurer for reimbursement from the Scholarship Fund.
- (d) A minimum of \$100.00 shall be retained in the Scholarship Fund for each year.

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ARTICLE III ELIGIBILITY

Any high school or college student is eligible to make application for the scholarship providing that the student meets the following requirements:

- (a) Files an application form furnished by the Metro Phoenix USBC Scholarship Committee, giving complete information as required thereon, by June 1st with the Secretary of the Metro Phoenix USBC Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be issued no later than July 31st.
- (b) Must have un-impaired amateur standing in all athletics.
- (c) Is a member of a league sanctioned in the Metro Phoenix USBC and is in good standing for the current season. (This does not apply to college students applying for addition funds under Article I (c).)
- (d) College students applying for additional funds (if available under Article I (c)), must maintain a "C" or better in each class. First year average must be "B" or better, second and third year average must be "B+" or better. A transcript of grades must be provided with the application and the applicant must be enrolled as a full time student.

ARTICLE IV AMENDMENTS:

This Scholarship Fund Constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the existing members of the Metro Phoenix USBC Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER

As revised shall govern the proceedings of all meeting of the Committee Members.
